

Tantalum Supply Chain Policy

Technologica Gesellschaft für High Tech Materialien und Verfahren mbH („Technologica“) supply high-quality tantalum products to the industry since established in 1970.

As a responsible company, we purchase semifinished tantalum products from longstanding reliable suppliers only.

With this policy, we confirm to commit to the regulation (EU) 2017/821 of the European Parliament and of the council: “Supply chain due diligence obligations for Union importers of tin, tantalum and tungsten, their ores, and gold originating from conflict-affected and high-risk areas”.

This includes but not limits our commitment:

- To condemn all activities in connection to unlawful exploitation of mineral resources.
- To not tolerate any forms of torture, cruel, inhuman and degrading treatment, forced or compulsory labour, worst forms of child labour, other gross human right violations and abuses such as widespread sexual violence, war crimes or other serious violations of international humanitarian law.
- To not tolerate any direct or indirect support to non-state armed groups nor tolerate the support of public and private security forces unlawfully controlling mining sites, transportation routes, etc.
- To not tolerate bribes in any form.
- To not accept any form of money laundering on our supply chain.
- To not tolerate any non-payments of taxes, duties and royalties related to the materials supplied to us.

In case we identify the abovementioned risks in our supply chain, we will suspend or discontinue the activities with those suppliers.

This supply chain policy is part of our Quality Management System and a fundamental basement of the insurance to supply conflict-free tantalum products to our valued customers.
